

# Kerbcraft

Mae'n dysgu plant 5-7 oed i gerdded yn ymyl ffordd yn fwy diogel drwy fynd â nhw ar ffyrdd go iawn a dangos iddyn nhw fod gwneud y penderfyniadau cywir, ac ymddwyn yn gywir, yn gallu eu helpu i fod yn ddiogel. ## 1. Dewis Lleodd a Llwybrau Diogel i Groesi'r Ffordd

Caiff y plant eu helpu i adnabod peryglon a dod o hyd i lleodd eraill i groesi.

## 2. Croesi'n Ddiogel lle mae Ceir wedi'u Parcio

Caiff y plant eu dysgu i ddefnyddio strategaeth ddiogel i groesi yn ymyl ceir sydd wedi'u parcio - os bydd hi'n amhosibl eu hosgoi.

## 3. Croesi'n Ddiogel yn ymyl Cyffyrdd

Caiff y plant eu cyflwyno i broblemau cyffyrdd syml a chymhleth ac fe ddysgan nhw strategaeth i edrych yn systematig i bob cyfeiriad.

**Caiff pob sgil ei ymarfer mewn sawl lle gwahanol dros gyfnod o 4-6 wythnos. Trefnir hynny mewn cysylltiad â'r ysgol a'i hamserlen.**

Pan fydd plant ifanc yn ymyl y ffordd, dylai oedolyn cyfrifol fod gyda nhw bob amser - hyd yn oed ar ôl iddyn nhw gael eu hyfforddi. Os anogwch chi'ch plentyn i ddysgu'r sgiliau hyn, bydd hynny'n ei helpu i'w hymarfer yn gyson.

Helping to Keep YOUR Child Safe on the Roads



# Kerbcraft

Kerbcraft teaches children aged from 5-7 how to be safer pedestrians by taking them onto real roads and showing them how the right decision-making and behaviour can really help them to keep safe. The children are taken out of school by trained volunteers, in groups of no more than three, to learn three main skills:

## 1. Choosing Safe Places and Routes to Cross the Road

Children are helped to recognise dangers and hazards and identify alternative crossing places.

## 2. Crossing Safely at Parked Cars

Children are taught how to use a safe strategy for crossing near parked cars - when avoiding them is impossible.

## 3. Crossing Safely Near Junctions

Children are introduced to the problems of simple and complex junctions, and taught a strategy for looking systematically in all directions.

**Each skill is practised at several different locations over a period of 4-6 weeks, in liaison with the school and its timetable.**

Young children should always be accompanied by a responsible adult when near the road - even after training. Your encouragement of these road safety skills will help your child to regularly practice them.
